Prof (FH) Mag Eva Werner Chair & Director

Appointed in 2010 as Director and Deputy Chair, Prof (FH) Mag Eva Werner has been Chair of THE-ICE Board since November 2013 and also remains an Auditor on the independent THE-ICE Assessment Panel.

Prof Werner holds a degree from the University of Vienna, and also studied in France and Canada. Her professional experience comprises lecturing at the College of Tourism, Vienna, full-time assistantship and teaching at the University of Business Administration Vienna and the Danube University Krems.

Prof Werner was one of the five Austrian Bologna Experts (the first in the field of Austrian Universities of Applied Sciences) and as such actively contributed to the implementation of the Bologna process. Her international commitment is highly recognised and was honoured in 2007 with the award of Honorary Professorship from the Moscow International Business School.

Prof Werner currently Chairs the International Committee of the National Conference of Universities of Applied Sciences, thus largely responsible for the representation of the Universities of Applied Sciences at an international level.

Prof Werner has been Rector of the IMC University of Applied Sciences Krems since 2010, the first female Rector of an Austrian University of Applied Sciences and responsible, among others, for the development and quality assurance of degree programmes on offer at IMC Krems.

A/Prof Laura Lawton Deputy Chair & Director

A/Prof Laura Lawton is Deputy Head at Griffith University, Australia, Department of Tourism, Leisure, Hotel and Sport Management. Laura was formally Program Director for the Master of Business Programs. Previous appointments include the University of South Carolina and George Mason University.

Holding a Master of Arts degree (Geography) and Bachelor of Arts (Honours, Urban Planning) from the University of Western Ontario, Canada, in 2002 she was awarded a PhD from Griffith University.

A/Prof Lawton is well-published in protected areas, ecotourism, resident perceptions of tourism, and cruise ship tourism - in 2011 being recognised in the Journal of Hospitality and Tourism Research as one of 50 most prolific tourism researchers and one of the top 100 researchers published in tourism and hospitality management.

Laura co-authored tourism text *Tourism Management* and served for five years as Editor-in-Chief for *Tourism Review International*. Also sitting on the Board of four other academic journals, Laura was awarded a Griffith University Group Learning Teaching Citation in 2011.

As well as being an Auditor on the independent THE-ICE Assessment Panel, A/Prof Lawton has acted as Director on THE-ICE Board since 2010 and Deputy Chair since 2013.

Professor Perry Hobson is the Pro Vice-Chancellor for Global Engagement at Taylor's University, Malaysia. He was the Director of THE-ICE from 2006-2011, and led the transformation of the organisation from being an initiative of the Australian Federal Government into being a not-for-profit international accreditation body. He has been a member of the Board of Directors since 2008.

Since 1999 Dr Hobson has been the Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Vacation Marketing and was also the co-Editor of the Journal of Hospitality and Tourism Education. In 2005, Perry was recognised in the Journal Tourism Management as being amongst the top 50 researchers in tourism and hospitality management over the previous two decades.

While he was the Head of the School of Tourism and Hospitality Management at SCU the School received the New South Wales (NSW) State Award for Excellence twice, and went onto win the National Australian Tourism Award for Education and Training.

Perry has also been a personal recipient of the Platinum Award for Tourism from the peak industry organization Tourism Training Australia (TTA) for his contribution to education. He has also twice been elected the Chair of the Council of Australian Universities for Tourism and Hospitality Education (CAUTHE) which is the national association of educators in Australia. Active in many international associations, Perry currently serves on the Boards of APacCHRIE and APTA, the two leading Asia-Pacific regional educators associations.
