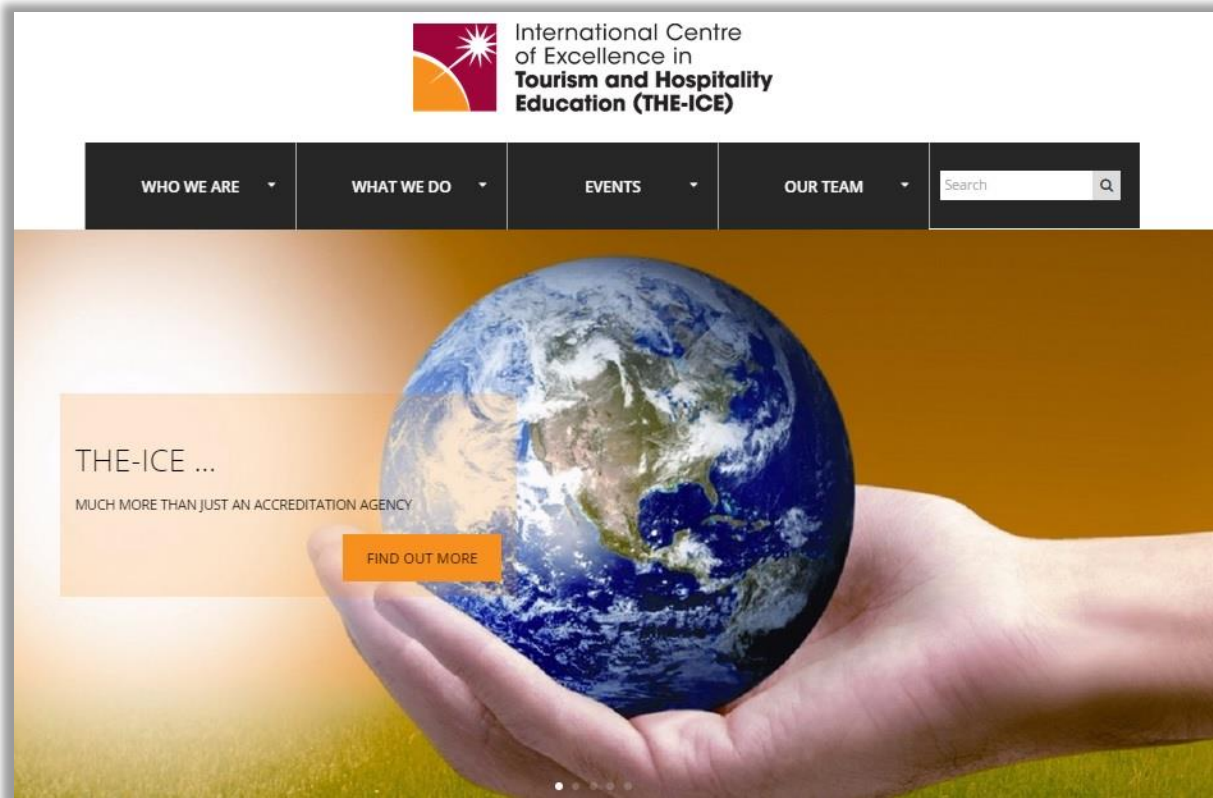

Dr Laura Lawton is an Associate Professor with the Department of Tourism, Sport and Hotel Management at Griffith University, Australia.

Laura has had extensive experience as Deputy Head and A/Head of Department at Griffith University and has also served as the Program Director for the Master of Business Programs. Previously she held appointments at the University of South Carolina and George Mason University, USA.

Prior to entering academia she was Senior Research Officer/Policy Analyst for Saskatchewan Environment and Natural Resources in Canada. A/Professor Lawton holds a Master of Arts degree (Geography) and Bachelor of Arts (Honours – Urban Planning) from the University of Western Ontario (Canada). In 2002 she was awarded a PhD from Griffith University.

A/Professor Lawton has published numerous government reports, academic journal articles and book chapters in several areas, including protected areas, ecotourism, resident perceptions of tourism, and cruise ship tourism. In 2011, Laura was recognised in the Journal of Hospitality and Tourism Research as one of the 50 most prolific tourism researchers in tourism and one of the top one 100 researchers published in the tourism and hospitality management over the last decade.

She is the co-author of the tourism text *Tourism Management*, published by John Wiley and Sons Australia, and served for five years as the Editor-and-Chief for *Tourism Review International*, an international refereed journal. She also sits on the board of four other academic journals. Laura was awarded a Griffith University Group Learning Teaching Citation in 2011.

Dr Lawton has been a Director on THE-ICE Board of Directors since December 2010 and has served as Deputy Chair since November 2013.
