



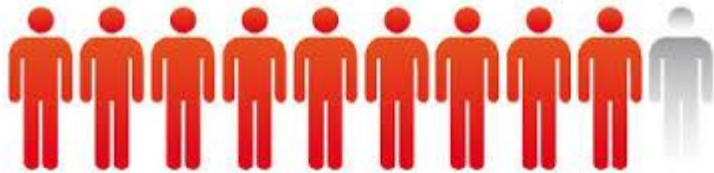


2004 Annual Poverty Indicator Service (Nationwide)

Families are grouped-

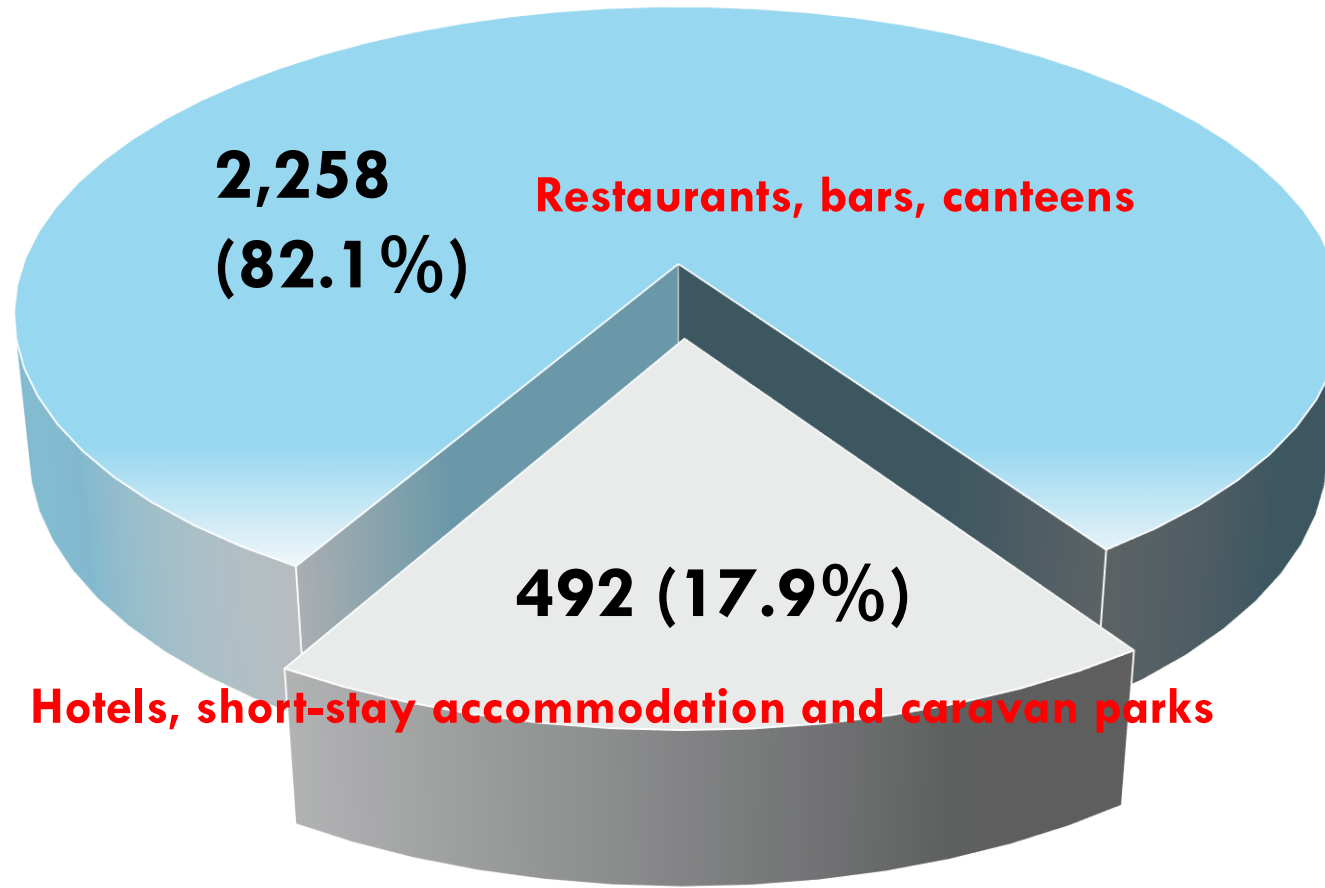
Lowest 30% (poor)
