Associate Professor Melanie Williams is Associate Dean (Scholarship) at William Angliss Institute, Melbourne. Her role is to work with teaching and academic staff to support a scholarly approach to learning and teaching across both vocational and higher education provision.

Melanie has worked in academic development for over twenty years in the Adult Community Education, Vocational Education and Training, and Higher Education sectors, including ten years running her own consulting business. With a particular focus on the provision of Higher Education in TAFE Institutes, Melanie has led the development of over thirty higher education courses for accreditation, trained and mentored vocational and higher education teachers, and mentored their scholarly development.

Research interests include the scholarships of learning, teaching and engagement, transformative learning, personal epistemology, and scenario planning – a practice of long term futures research. Her PhD explored the use of scenario planning to foster worldview transformation.
