- Nearly 9,000 student responses in 2018

- 2. Introducing THE-ICE Benchmark Rating Report (BRR)
- From 2018 onward THE-ICE will be offering 'THE-ICE Benchmark Rating Report' (BRR), analysed and collated by i- graduate, annually.
- Conducted in partnership with UK-based company i-graduate, THE-ICE BRR will be in addition to the annual mandatory THE-ICE ISBSB Survey reports as part of its deliverables to THE-ICE Full Members.
- Follows a successful pilot based on retrospective analysis of THE-ICE members' ISBSB Survey 2017 findings.









THE-ICE Benchmark Rating Report point of difference

Unlike other ranking systems, THE-ICE BRR is based on statistical data:

- 258,971 students from 194 institutions participated in the global i-graduate 2018 ISBSB survey.
 - 8,839 students from 22 institutions in 11 countries participated in THE-ICE ISBSB survey.









THE-ICE Benchmark Rating Report benefits

- THE-ICE's interest in conducting this annual Survey is primarily for the ongoing internal quality assurance enhancement and improvement of THE-ICE member institutions and their respective education programmes.
- Benchmarking against others in the sector provides a channel for the sharing of best-practice on common issues.
- For THE-ICE Members, the BRR provides real data to use as marketing statements for student retention, attraction and branding.









2018 preliminary results

- Emirates Academy of Hospitality Management rated #1 for research.
- Lyceum of the Philippines University (LPU)'s Cavite campus rated #1 for learning and support overall, and living average.
- Torrens University Australia Blue Mountains International Hotel Management School rated #1 for language support and top 5 for work experience.
- Swiss Education Group campuses rated #1 for overall living and arrival and top 10 for expert lecturers, teachers and learning support.
- University of the South Pacific rated top 5 for expert lecturers, employability & good contacts.
- University of Santo Tomas rated top 5 for worship facilities, host friends, formal welcome, accommodation cost and language support.
- William Angliss Institute rated in top 10 across elements within learning, living and arrival.
